# Mother Cabrini's Work Continues at Emmaus...



St. Frances Xavier Cabrini, also known as Mother Cabrini, a religious sister from Italy and founder of the Missionaries of

the Sacred Heart of Jesus, came to the United States in 1889 to work with Italian immigrants at the suggestion of Pope Leo XIII. Prior to government-funded social service programs, Mother Cabrini set up orphanages, soup kitchens, hospitals, and other institutions to serve the sick and the poor in New York City, Chicago, and various locations throughout the country. Mother Cabrini died in Chicago while preparing Christmas candy for local children. St. Frances

Xavier Cabrini led an exemplary life of service to God and those most in need. Along with St. Marianne Cope, we know Mother Cabrini is a great intercessor for all the incredible work that takes place at Emmaus Ministry. Last year, Emmaus Ministry was the recipient of a \$200,000 grant from the Mother Cabrini Health Foundation located in New York City. This grant was awarded to Emmaus due to our commitment to care for the overall well-being of each and every individual who comes through our doors. Emmaus is much more than a place for people to come and just receive food. People come for socialization; they come to share their personal and health needs knowing that they will

find a listening ear and many willing advocates; they come knowing that they belong and that they will not be judged. People who come to Emmaus know they will be embraced by God's love, mercy, and compassion.

Many stories are told of Mother Cabrini. One such story is that she would often be seen with her arms outstretched, embracing the poor. It is comforting knowing her life and mission continue on the south side of Syracuse. At Emmaus Ministry, our open door is just like the outstretched arms of Mother Cabrini, as we are always there to welcome and share God's love with all we encounter!

# **Emmaus Ministry Goes Mobile**

Starting in mid-November, Emmaus will be returning to our roots by taking meals to the neighborhoods, in addition to continuing our operations at our Glen Avenue outreach center. With your support, we have been able to purchase a large van that will accommodate food storage units, both for hot food and cold drinks. The van replaces our previous "HOPE MOBILE" and will be easily recognizable throughout the neighborhoods.

Many people cannot reach our center due to a lack of transportation and are still in great need. Our plan is to begin serving in one nearby neighborhood, approximately 1.5 miles away, 2-3 times per week. Eventually, with your continued assistance, we will expand to an additional neighborhood or

two, providing much needed meals to multiple areas of the city.

Steve Nowicki will be overseeing our mobile ministry (read about Steve in this newsletter). He will drive the van loaded with food to predetermined sites, set out the awning that is attached to the van,

and distribute meals to all who arrive. Our kitchen staff will be called on to prepare hundreds of more meals each week as we expand our services to include many more of our city's

# Pandemic's Impact on Meal Distribution

Emmaus Ministry has experienced a steady increase in the number of meals being served since just before the pandemic hit. The year started with an average of approximately 240 meals per week being distributed from January 1 through mid-March. Since the pandemic hit, we have moved to a take out service only. The average number of meals distributed weekly since mid-March has increased to 770 meals. Perhaps the most telling number is the average weekly distribution in September: 1,207 meals. That is nearly a 500% increase in the number of meals being distributed each week compared to just before the start of the health crisis.

Each week there are new guests arriving at our doors for meals. On one occasion during the summer months, an individual presented herself at Emmaus to pick up meals for a friend. When asked if she wanted a meal, the visitor was surprised to learn that anyone who wants a meal will be served.

She had five children who needed food. That one visitor was able to feed her family of six that day, as well as many days after that, as she became a regular visitor to our outreach center.

When we contacted you through a direct mailing, telling you of the dramatic increase in meals being distributed, your response was overwhelming. Your generosity allowed us to meet the increased demand that we were experiencing in the spring and summer months, when the increase in meals served was in the 200-300% range. We are being challenged even more so with the September numbers showing a 500% increase. As the holidays approach, we anticipate at the very least to continue serving at the current levels. However, the number of visitors in need of hot meals may very well continue to lead to ever increasing numbers.

We will continue to provide meals to anyone who presents themselves at our door in need of food. With no end to

# The Start of a New Ministry

They will call to fulfill any needs that they may have, but will also let them know that they are loved.
