



Revealing God's presence to those in need began with a sandwich.

Emmaus Ministry began in 2009, preparing sandwiches in the basement of St. James Church (now known as Our Lady of Hope). As parishioners, we were challenged to “go forth”, to bring the love of a merciful God outside of the brick and mortar of the parish to those isolated and forgotten. Soon, we were at the door of the Catholic Charities Emergency Shelter for Men (formerly known as The OX), with pans of hot food, drinks, toiletries and socks embracing the God's lonely with open arms. The Hope Mobile van became our center of this mobile ministry stretching beyond the men's shelter to individuals living under bridges and in camps, to the Dorothy Day House for homeless women, to the neighborhoods of Syracuse's south side, to Bishop Foery Foundation after school program and sites in between.

When we meet God's people on the periphery of society, meet them where they are, relationships

develop and trust is formed. Through the corporal and spiritual works of mercy, Emmaus Ministry then ministers to their spiritual and physical needs, to reveal God's love and mercy.

In 2014, Emmaus Ministry became a 501(c) 3 charity and opened an outreach center at 4335 S. Salina Street, in Syracuse. Today, the St. Marianne Cope Center for Outreach serves approximately 225 meals each week, distributes 85 bags of groceries and personal care items, provides a shower and laundry ministry which includes haircuts and foot care, offers children's activities, is a neighborhood site for weekly AA meetings and provides bi-monthly activities at Onondaga Boulevard Senior Housing.

In the Gospel of Luke, the disciples on the Road to Emmaus ask our Lord to “stay with us”. Since 2009, Emmaus continues to “stay” with those we serve and to provide a place of acceptance, hospitality and community to give dignity to all.
